An Act to revive S.L. McNally Consulting Services Inc.

Preamble

Sherry L. McNally has applied for special legislation to revive S.L. McNally Consulting Services Inc. The applicant represents that she was the sole shareholder and president of the corporation when it is dissolved. The corporation was dissolved under the *Business Corporations Act* on August 13, 2009 pursuant to articles of dissolution. The applicant represents that business has been carried on in the name of the corporation despite the dissolution and that she would like to revive the corporation in order to continue carrying on its business.

It is appropriate to grant the application.

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

Corporation revived

1. S.L. McNally Consulting Services Inc. is revived and is, subject to any rights acquired by any person after its dissolution, restored to its legal position, including all its property, rights, privileges and franchises and subject to all its liabilities, contracts, disabilities and debts, as of the date of its dissolution, in the same manner and to the same extent as if it had not been dissolved.

Commencement

2. This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal Assent.

Short title

3. The short title of this Act is the S.L. McNally Consulting Services Inc. Act, 2010.
