An Act to amend the Marriage Act

His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

- 1 (1) Subsection 24 (1) of the Marriage Act is amended by adding the following paragraph:
 - 3.1 A member of the Assembly who has given written notice to the Minister indicating an interest in solemnizing marriages.
- (2) Section 24 of the Act is amended by adding the following subsection:

(2) Subsection (1) continues to apply to a person described in paragraph 3.1 of that subsection for a period of 12 months after the day the person ceases to be a member of the Assembly.

Commencement

2 This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal Assent.

Short title

3 The short title of this Act is the Marriage Amendment Act, 2025.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Explanatory Note was written as a reader's aid to Bill 31 and does not form part of the law. Bill 31 has been enacted as Chapter 20 of the Statutes of Ontario, 2025.

The Bill amends the *Marriage Act* to authorize a member of the Assembly to solemnize marriages under the authority of a licence if they have given written notice to the Minister. The authorization would last for a period of 12 months after the day the person ceases to be a member of the Assembly.
