- That the deadline for requests to appear be 12:00 p.m. on Friday, October 6, 2017, and that the Committee be authorized to consider and schedule requests received after the deadline; and
- That witnesses be scheduled to appear before the Committee on a first-come first-served basis; and
- That the deadline for written submissions be 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 12, 2017; and
- That the deadline for filing amendments to the Bill with the Clerk of the Committee shall be 12:00 p.m. on Friday, October 13, 2017 and that the Committee be authorized to consider late amendments; and
- That the Committee be authorized to meet on Monday, October 16, 2017 and Wednesday, October 18, 2017 during its regularly scheduled meeting times for the purpose of clause-by-clause consideration of the Bill; and

That, when the Order for Third Reading of the Bill is called, 3 hours of debate shall be allotted to the Third Reading stage of the Bill, apportioned equally among the recognized parties.
